# What is the Relay For Life®?

- It is a life-changing event that brings together more than 3.5 million people each year to:
  - Celebrate the lives of those who have battled cancer. The strength of survivors and caregivers inspires others to continue to fight.
  - Remember loved ones lost to the disease. At Relay, people who have lost family and friends to cancer can grieve and find healing and support.
  - Fight back against a disease that takes too much. We Relay because we have been touched by cancer and are committed to putting an end to the disease.



# Relay For Life



- RFL is similar to a walk-a-thon but so much more.
  - It's usually a 12-hour event held in a designated location like a park or school field or company parking lot where teams come together to celebrate with food, music and activities with survivors and care givers.
  - Team members take turns walking around the track continuously over the 12-hour period.
  - During the event, time is taken to remember by having a luminary program where participants place candles around the track remembering all those we have lost to cancer.
  - Participants also celebrate those who have survived cancer!
  - Many teams use the events to fund raise by having a booth to sell food or other products.
