Z-HOPETM Eligibility Rules:

- Must have a minimum of 4 Zetas/4 Amicae/ 4 Zeta Youth
- Submit donations at the Regional Conference.

Project Instructions:

Please review this link https://m25m.org/pillbottles/ on specific requirements for our donations. Acceptable collection items must meet these requirements.

- Prescription and over-the-counter pill bottles
- Large and small pill bottles
- Pill Bottles with and without secure caps (child-resistant)
- Bottles included in shipments of medical supplies must have an all plastic lid.
- Bottles should be sorted by color and type.
- All labels should be removed, leaving no glue or residue.
- All bottles and lids should be washed in very hot water and dish soap, rinsed, and dried thoroughly.
- Caps should be placed back onto clean, dried bottles.
- Clean, recapped bottles should be placed into large resealable bags marked "Clean Bottles." These will be included in shipments of medical supplies.

Maximizing Our Resources to provide Extraordinary service

All bags of appropriate pill bottles <u>MUST</u> be stored/submitted in a plastic tote with a lid. 25 points for every 25 items. Please write on the side of your tote, the number of pill bottles inside of the tote.

ALL donations must be dropped off at the designated location by 4:30pm on Thursday June 29th.

Z-HOPETM Reporting:

- All **Z-HOPE**TM programs must be logged in to the Zeta Service Management System via the International Website: https://zphib1920.org/programs-initiatives/z-hope/zsms/ You may receive a system generated confirmation of the information submitted.
- Entries are due into the ZSMS no later than **June 30, 2023.**
- Remember to add the service project to your chapter **Z-HOPE**TM spreadsheet.
